HOW TO REGISTER FOR DECEASED DONOR KIDNEY TRANSPLANT IN GOA

REGISTRATION PRE REQUISITES

- CKD Stage 5
- Minimum 3 months of dialysis
- No age limit
- No domicile requirement





HOW MUCH DOES THE TRANSPLANT SURGERY COST?

- DDSSY & PMJAY schemes provide cover for renal transplant surgery and post transplant immunosuppressive medications.
- At Goa Medical College, the service is provided free of cost inclusive of lifelong immunosuppressive medications

WHOM TO CONTACT FOR REGISTRATION?

- Treating Nephrologist
- Transplant Coordinator of the hospital you wish to undertake the transplant in.

MHAT TO EXPECT NEXT \$

- Nephrology consultation and evaluation to ascertain medical fitness & rule out physical/psychological conditions which are absolute contraindications (infections, malignancies, advanced cardio vascular disease, uncontrolled psychiatric disorders) to undertake a transplant.
- As per institutional protocol, all the laboratory & radiological investigations are done.
- Fitness is sought from certain key departments like urology, cardiology, surgery, OBG (in case of females)
- After the clearance is given, Transplant coordinator will provide you the following list of documents required to upload for enlisting you and generating a priority score.

LIST OF DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION?

- 1) PHOTO (1 Passport Size Photo)
- 2) IDENTITY PROOF (AADHAR CARD/VOTER CARD/PANCARD/PASSPORT/DRIVING LICENCE)
- 3) PROOF OF AGE
- 4) BLOOD GROUP REPORT
- 5) SEROLOGY REPORT (Viral Markers-HIV, Hepatitis B & C)
- 6) PROOF OF FIRST DIALYSIS
- 7) PROOF OF AV FISTULA/GRAFT/CAPD THAT HAS FAILED
- 8) PROOF OF ANY NEAR RELATIVE BEING A DECEASED ORGAN DONOR
- 9) PROOF OF PREVIOUS KIDNEY TRANSPLANT WHICH HAS FAILED

HOW IS THE SCORE GENERATED?

- 1) Failure of Dialysis Access AV Fistula/Graft/CAPD 0.2 point per failed AV fistula or graft (max of 1)
- 2) Age <18 years-3 points, 18 to 45 years -2 points, >45 years-1 point
- 3) Period on Dialysis 0.1 point per month on dialysis
- 4) Period of Registration 0.1 point per month of Registration
- 5) Previous failed Kidney Grafts 2 point if kidney transplant failed within one year & 1 point if later
- 6) Near relative (THOTA 1994) of previous deceased donor now requiring kidney transplant 5 points
- 7) Previous Living Donor now requiring a kidney transplant 10 points

WAITING LIST IS BASED ON

- BLOOD GROUP (A,B,O,AB)
- HOSPITAL (Public And Private Sector Hospital)

Unique SOTTO ID number for purpose of tracking will be intimated by the transplant coordinator

WHEN WILL I GET A KIDNEY TRANSPLANT?

As and when a braindead donor in the ICU of the hospital where you are registered consents for organ donation, depending on the donors blood group, the recipients enlisted in that hospital under that blood group are allocated the organ as per rank.

It entirely depends on where the donor is admitted e.g. if donor in GMC, then 1st preference to GMC listed patients if donor in Private Hospital, then 1st preference to that Private Hospital listed patients

You will receive a call from the transplant coordinator on your registered mobile number

HOW TO CHECK STATUS OF RANK ON LIST?

Visit website of SOTTO Goa <u>www.sotto.goa.gov.in</u> Click on the tab "Patient Ranking" Enter blood group, year of registering and the SOTTO ID number.

On clicking 'search', the status as Active/Inactive/ & over all rank on the list is displayed.

WHAT COULD BE THE REASON FOR BEING REJECTED INSPITE OF BEING ALLOCATED KIDNEY?

- Medically unfit as per the clinical examination & investigations send as pre operative evaluation for fitness.
- HLA Not Matching
- Donor family withdrew consent & no organ donation happened
- You could have been 3rd on the list and the No. 1& 2 were
 medically fit and HLA matching (First five wait listed patients are called at a
 time and evaluation is done as the work up is time consuming)
